Meeting Minutes

- Introductions of BLV Group and Alberta Transportation Attendees.
- Recap of last meeting minutes.

Open the floor to discuss concerns.

- 1) Silica Exposure
 - a. Concerns with exposure to the general public.
 - b. Exposure limits and who is responsible for setting the limits.
- 2) Noise & 24 Hour Operations
 - a. Backup alarms left on at night.
 - b. Complaints should be directed to BLV or Glen at Alberta Transportation, rather than the minister to ensure a prompt response.
 - c. STAR is within the City Calgary and follows the City of Calgary Noise By-laws
 - d. Residents voiced concerns with the Alberta Transportation contracts and the 24 hour crushing.
 - e. Questions to Alberta Transportation and limiting the contract hours? Alberta Transportation will look into the feasibility of this and respond.
 - f. Residents would like to see restricted hours, preferably 7am-7pm.
 - g. Questions on raising the berm, the berm is for visual screening and does not act as a sound barrier.
- 3) Sound Monitoring
 - a. Portable sound monitor to be deployed next week.
 - b. Concerns that there should be more monitors on the West side of the property, capturing sound levels from different areas.
- 4) Attendance
 - a. Would like to see better notifications and more communities invited.
 - b. BLV would like this to stay focused and deal with the concerns of the residents near to the site.
