UPDATE SINCE LAST MEETING

- Traffic study of pit entrance nearly completed. Report provided to Lorne Milz. The report is 138 pages and can't be placed on the webpage or e-mailed due to its size.
- Final segment of natural gas line installed into Stoney Trail. A concrete pad has been poured and the gas meter/attachment point is currently being installed. Complete installation anticipated by May 15th.

GENERAL

- Discussion about Stoney Trail Schedule. At this time, there are three major activities planned for the pit:
 - 1) South Rock Asphalt Plant returning to complete paving requirements on NW ring road
 - 2) Crushing for new AT project (Stoney Trail and Deerfoot interchange). Please note that this project is in the process of being awarded. The likely contractor has indicated that it will not be bringing an asphalt plant into Stoney Trail to produce for this contract.
 - 3) BLV crushing

At this time the schedule is as follows:

April	1) Asphalt plant moved in to complete work on the NW ring road during the week of April 27 th . This plant is still utilizing diesel fuel as per its contract from last year.
May	1) Crushing work for new AT project to begin. 2) Asphalt plant should complete work on NW ring road and move out.
June	1) Crushing work for AT finishes by month end. 2) No new asphalt plant. Contractor has decided not to bring a plant in for this contract. Going to take material from a different source.

July	1) Stripping project in order to expose more material for mining.
August	1) BLV crusher begins work. Crushing likely to last until November.

- Discussion about noise coming from the pit. A continued discussion about the possibilities of using enclosures on crushing equipment in order to mitigate noise. Further discussion about new berms to provide noise barriers. Further discussion about limiting hours of operation in order to alleviate night time noise.
- New actions this year to help with noise include the use of tandem trucks for stockpiling. These trucks are highway vehicles and should produce less noise than previously utilized rock trucks.
- It should be noted that BLV / AT has received numerous complaints related to the start-up of the asphalt plant. These have mostly been in the form of e-mails from various parties. No one came to the meeting however most complaints seemed to focus on the fact that the plant wasn't utilizing natural gas a fuel source. This was never the intent as the plant is completing requirements on an old job under an existing contract. Only new contracts were going to utilize the natural gas line. Hopefully, the June open house will provide an opportunity to communicate with local residents.
- Open House plans are proceeding. A draft newsletter has been completed and was provided to AT today for their review. This will be mailed out in the first week of June in order to provide adequate notice for anyone who wishes to attend. At this time, a revised date of June 20 has been suggested for the open house.

YOUNG OFFENDERS CENTER

- Still concerned with dust at facility for employees, offenders, and guests.
- Kurt did not receive copy of traffic study.
- Is Kevin Brophy receiving exceedance e-mails?
- Possible concerns at the University Research Park.
- Dust and debris beginning to be a concern as material begins to be hauled out of Stoney Trail.

ACTIONS

- BLV to confirm that Kevin Brophy is receiving auto e-mails for any monitoring exceedances.
 - BLV to carefully monitor dust and debris at entrance. Need to mobilize dust control equipment as required as the truck traffic increases.
 - Anyone who wishes to receive a copy of the traffic study as completed by Opus Engineering should e-mail me at travis.coates@stoneytrailpit.ca. Arrangements will be made to provide a hard copy or CD.
 - Newsletter to be finalized. BLV to continue planning for a June Open House. Newsletter will be used to advertise the event.
