UPDATE SINCE LAST MEETING

- No asphalt plant in pit. Nothing scheduled until next year at the earliest.
- BLV crusher now in pit producing various materials. It is estimated the crusher will remain in Stoney Trail for the rest of the year and shut down in late November or early December.

Public Open House held on June 20th.

- Had sign boards placed in three locations around the pit for three weeks leading up to the event. 700 BLV newsletters were distributed to residents in Rocky Ridge and Royal Oak one week prior to the event.
- Open house had a bus tour that showed the active mining area at Stoney (no operations at the time) and the new gas line. The tour also went through Lafarge's Spy Hill Pit.
- Attendance was low. We estimate that only 90 people came to the event.
- Other than the low attendance, the event went very well.

GENERAL

At this time the schedule is as follows:

September	BLV crusher to continue producing. Trucks in and out of the site for material sales. No asphalt plant.
October	BLV crusher to continue producing. Trucks in and out of the site for material sales. No asphalt plant.
November	BLV crusher to continue producing. Trucks in and out of the site for material sales. No asphalt plant.
December	Winter shut down.

- Crushers working at the very bottom now.
- Suggestion made to send out notification to stakeholders any time there is a major change at Stoney Trail (ie: new crusher moving in or out, asphalt plant moving in or out, stripping project start or finish).

YOUNG OFFENDERS CENTER

- Still concerned with dust at facility for employees, offenders, and guests.
- Is Kevin Brophy receiving exceedance e-mails? Yes.
- Possible concerns at the University Research Park.
- Dust and debris beginning to be a concern as material begins to be hauled out of Stoney Trail.

ACTIONS

- BLV to complete Silica testing at YOC.
- BLV to carefully monitor dust and debris at entrance. Need to mobilize dust control equipment as required as the truck traffic increases.
- BLV to send out e-mail to stakeholders any time there is a major change at the gravel pit.

- Low attendance during last two night time meetings. Will change back to afternoon meetings for now.
